Tasting

Nose/aromas: Discreet with a closed nose, impressions of (sweet) malt, fruit, yeast and a subtle hint of honey.

Flavour: Frank and powerful yet subtle in the mouth, discreet malty attack followed by a lovely presence of bitter hops, slightly sweet finish. 7.5%
